NOTICE

Sullivan County has adopted a rule forbidding the sale, storage, manufacture or distribution of beer and like beverages within 300 feet of residential dwellings, measured from building to building, when any owner of such residential dwelling appears in person to state an objection.

Sullivan County has also adopted a rule forbidding the sale, storage, manufacture or distribution of beer and like beverages within 300 feet of schools, churches, or other places of public gathering, regardless of whether an owner objects or not.

CERTIFICATE / ACKNOWLEDGMENT

I certify that I am knowledgeable of the laws prohibiting the sale of beer to minors, and that this application contains true information to the best of my knowledge and belief. I acknowledge and agree that I shall not be issued a permit or my permit shall be revoked if my business location causes traffic congestion or interferes with schools, churches, or other places of public gathering, or otherwise interferes with public health, safety and morals. I certify that no school, church, or other place of public gathering is within 300 feet of my business location, and understand and agree that my permit shall be revoked should evidence establish otherwise. I acknowledge and agree that a survey prepared at my expense by a registered land surveyor licensed by the State of Tennessee which demonstrates residential dwellings, schools, churches or other places of public gathering within 300 feet of my business, when measured building to building from the closest points of each, may be required at any time at the discretion of the Beverage Board.

NOTICE

A non-refundable fee of \$250.00 must accompany this application. If the application is approved you are required to provide documentation of sales tax registration to the county within ten days of approval. Any applicant making any false statement in this application shall forfeit his permit and shall not be eligible to receive any permit for a period of ten years.

A privilege tax of \$100 is imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer in this state effective January 1, 1994 and each successive January 1. Any holder of a beer permit issued after January 1, 1994 shall pay a pro-rata portion of this annual tax when the permit is issued.

A Certificate of Registration (application for sales tax number) issued by the State of Tennessee must be received by the Secretary to the Beverage Board within ten days of issuance of beverage permit.

Permits shall be issued to the owner of the business, whether a person, firm, corporation, joint-stock company, syndicate, or association.

A permit is only for a single location and is valid for all decks, patios, and other outdoor serving areas that are contiguous to the exterior of the building in which the business is located.

Where an owner operates two or more restaurants or other businesses within the same building, the owner may, in his or her discretion, operate some or all of such businesses under the same permit.

A permit is valid only for the business of the owner named in the permit.

A permit holder must return a permit to the county or city that issued it within fifteen (15) days of termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business name. A change in ownership occurs for a corporate owner when at least fifty percent (50%) of the stock of the corporation is transferred to a new owner. **Notwithstanding the failure to return a beer permit, a permit shall expire upon termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business's name.**
