RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SULLIVAN COUNTY SHERIFF'S QUALIFICATION ACT

WHEREAS, TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED; SECTION \_\_\_\_\_, AUTHORIZES COUNTIES

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan  
County, Tennessee, assembled in Regular Session on the 21st day  
of March, 1988.

THAT this resolution establishes mandatory qualifications and training for newly elected  
county sheriffs, for the purpose of promoting the orderly transfer of law enforcement powers  
within this county and to insure the election of qualified law enforcement professionals to  
this important county office.

QUALIFICATIONS: (A) In order to be eligible to be elected or appointed to the office of county  
sheriff on or after July 1, 1988, the candidate or appointee shall:

1. Be a citizen of the United States;
2. Have been a resident of the county for at least three (3) years preceding the date of the  
or appointment;
3. Be a registered voter of the county;
4. Be at least twenty-five (25) years old prior to the date of the appointment or the qualifying  
date of the election;
5. Not have a conviction or guilty plea or plea of Nolo contendere in any felony case for  
violation of any federal or state law relating to force, violence, theft, dishonesty,  
gambling, liquor or controlled substances and not have been released or discharged under  
other than honorable conditions from any of the armed forces of the United States;
6. Be a certified police officer as defined by the Tennessee Peace Officer Standards and  
training Commission;
7. Be fingerprinted under the direction of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, which will  
maintain such fingerprints on file. Such fingerprints must be taken no later than twenty-  
four (24) hours after the qualifying deadline for all candidates seeking election to the  
office of county sheriff. The Bureau shall conduct a search of local, state and federal  
fingerprint files to disclose any criminal record of any person appointed or seeking  
election to the office of county sheriff.
8. And at least one of the following:
  - a. Have a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in Criminal Justice or Business; or
  - b. Have at least an associate's degree or its equivalent and at least five (5) years  
experience in a law enforcement field; or

c. Have a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in any field and five (5) years experience in a position requiring supervision of personnel and operational management.

(B) The county legislative body or a committee appointed by the county legislative body must review the qualifications of all candidates seeking the office of county sheriff, to determine whether they meet the requirements of this section. In the case of candidates for election, the county legislative body or committee appointed by the body must certify to the county election commission that a candidate has met the requirements of this section prior to the candidate's name being placed on the ballot. Candidates for election to the office of county sheriff and persons appointed to fill vacancies in the office of county sheriff must provide the county legislative body or designated committee with the following information.

1. A complete history of places of residence for the past six (6) years including house numbers or rural route numbers, street, city, county and state;
2. A complete employment history for the past six (6) years including name and address of employers and period of time employed.
3. A certified copy of birth certificate, high school diploma or its recognized equivalency and of all college transcripts evidencing qualifications required by this section;
4. Such other information as may reasonably be required by the committee to assist in determining compliance with the requirements of this section.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, financing will be with Revenue Deficient General Obligation Bonds  
and construction should begin in 1988.

near Brooklea Circle.

(2) Johnson City, TN and/or Bluff City, TN

A sanitary sewer line along Highway 11-E from Edgefield Road to "Partners" Restaurant.

(3) Kingsport, TN

(a) A sanitary sewer line along Peaveler Branch from Stone Drive to Bloomingdale Pike.

(b) A sanitary sewer line along Lebanon Road from the Kendrick Creek Trunk line to  
Colonial Heiths Middle School.

(c) A sanitary sewer line along Fordtown Road from Miller Perry Elementary School.

(d) A sanitary sewer line along each side of Fort Henry Drive from Kendricks Street  
southeast to the Clinchfield Railroad overpass.

(e) A sanitary sewer line along Bloomingdale Pike and Bloomington Drive from Mill Street  
to about 200 feet southwest of Arbutus Avenue, then southeast up a branch to  
Delrose Street. This line will be installed by the J and W Development Company, under  
the County's policy for developer-installed lines.





BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 609 of the Private Acts of 1935 as amended by Chapter 27 of the Private Acts of 1935 (first extraordinary session), and Chapter 288 of the Private Acts of 1974 is further amended by adding the following words after the words "tax delinquency matters":

unless otherwise assigned to the delinquent tax attorney for prosecution after appointment by the county trustee with approval of the county executive.

SECTION 2 is further amended by adding the following language at the end of the section:

Compensation for the delinquent tax attorney shall be negotiated between the county trustee in accordance with state statutory procedure and orders of the chancery court regulating delinquent tax collection procedure.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of Sullivan County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the county legislative body and certified by him to the Secretary of State.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective upon being approved as provided in Section 2.


