Georgia Warren was present, no opposition was heard. Staff recommended that the April 21, 1992 generalized land use plan prepared and adopted by the commission for the new U. S. 19-E Highway corridor - the area in which the Warren request is located - be followed in evaluating the request. Based on the plan staff recommended rezoning as follows: (1) parcel 78.2 fronting on the west side of Old U. S. Highway 19-E approximately 600 feet south of the Heath Road

Intersection should remain R-1 low density residential as currently zoned, a designation that is compatible with existing land use in the area, (2) the approximate northern one half of parcel 147 fronting on the east side of Old U. S. Highway 19-E approximately 800 feet north of the new U. S. Highway 19-E intersection should be zoned PRD (Planned Residential District), and the approximate southern one half of parcel 147 located at the intersection of the old and new U. S. Highway 19-E should be zoned PBD (planned business district), both proposed zones being compatible with surrounding land uses, (3) that portion of the property located on the northwest quadrant of the old and new U. S. Highway 19-E intersection with frontage on new U. S. Highway 19-E of approximately 900 feet and an approximate depth paralleling the highway right-of-way at 250 feet, should be zoned PBD (Planned Business District), and a designation compatible with surrounding land uses, (4) the approximate southern one half of parcel 79 fronting for approximately 800 feet on the westerly side of new U.S. Highway 19-E approximately 800 feet north of the Southern Railroad should be zoned PMD (planned manufacturing district), a designation being compatible with surrounding land use. The applicant Georgia Warren accepted staff recommendations after discussion.
