THAT Whereas, Sullivan County is considering locating space for a dog burial ground or funding an incinerator for disposal of dogs, and

Whereas, medical research laboratories in universities all over the country are desperate to secure dogs for their scientists to use in developing procedures and medicines which will alleviate human suffering and diseases, and

Whereas, because these schools cannot afford to buy dogs bred for this purpose,

Be It Resolved, That instead of euthanasia and burial or incineration of unwanted dogs, Sullivan County make arrangements with any accredited university laboratory to donate these dogs to the university provided the university furnish transportation of the dogs from the proposed pound to the university.
