This is to notify each of you that there is a vacancy in the 5th Commission District of Sullivan County for the Office of Constable due to the resignation of Sammy W. Shaffer.

The following is a summary of what Tennessee law requires in order to fill a vacancy in the office of Constable:

- A. T.C.A. 8-10-118 states that a vacancy in the office of Constable is to be filled pursuant to the provisions of T.C.A. 5-1-104.
- B. T.C.A. 5-1-104 provides that the vacancy is to be filled by the county legislative body.
- C. T.C.A.8-10-102(b) (1) provides that a person seeking to fill the vacancy must file an affidavit with the County Clerk prior to election.
- D. T.C.A.5-5-113 provides that the County Clerk must give ten days notice to members of the county legislative body
- E. T.C.A. 5-5-114 states that in addition to the notice required by T.C.A.5-5-113 the chairman of the county legislative body shall cause public notice to be given in a newspaper of general circulation in the county at least one (1) week before the meeting of the county legislative body, specifying the office to be filled at that meeting. This requirement may only be satisfied by a paid legal notice run at least one full week, 7 days, prior to the meeting.
- F. T.C.A. 5-5-115 provides that the county legislative body must hold an open election "admitting all citizens to the privilege of offering as candidates, except such as are prohibited by the constitution or laws of the state." This means that all citizens must be offered the opportunity at the meeting to be nominated as a candidate to fill the office, and all citizens must be allowed the opportunity to make nominations.

This is to further notify you that the election to fill this vacancy that was held on June 18, 2007 at the Regular Commission Meeting was not conducted in compliance with T.C.A. requirements and therefore will be conducted again on July 16, 2007 at the Regular Commission Meeting at 9:00 A.M.

This notice is given in accordance with T.C.A. Section 5-5-113, which requires ten (10) days notice, prior to this date.





RESOLUTION Authorizing Study and Development of Plan and Implementation to Install County-Wide Emergency Alert Siren System in Sullivan County

WHEREAS, Sullivan County does not have a current system in place with the capability of notifying all or a specific portion of its citizens of impending emergencies such as flooding, hail storm, tornado, etc.; and

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

Employees whose current pay rate is within the salary grade receive one of the following:

- • If they are within their first five years of employment- 3% COLA
- • If they are above the midpoint they would receive a 3% Cola
- If they are below the midpoint of their salary grade and have more than five years tenure they receive and additional percentage to bring them closer to the midpoint:
 - \circ \circ 5-10 years of employment = 4%
 - \circ \circ 10-15 years of employment = 5%
 - $\circ \circ 15 +$ years of employment = 6%
- Employees with more than five years of employment whose adjustment to the minimum rate is less than they would receive based on longevity will receive the difference in longevity.

Maintenance of the Pay Plan

- • Attempt to keep employees' pay current by providing annual COLA increases approximating increases in the CPI (Consumer Price Index)
- • Review the entire pay plan periodically (every three to five years at current rates of inflation) to ensure that the plan remains competitive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no employees receive less than a 3% COLA and a 2.25% pay adjustment for the 2007 - 2008 budget year.
