My name is Patricia Duncan Jarrard and I would like to be considered for the Board of Directors of the Sullivan County Library.



## Piney Flats Area Soldier War Victim

PINEY FLATS, Tenn. — Sgt. Stephen J. Torbett, 26, of Route 2, Piney Flats, died Aug. 14 of wounds suffered in action in Vietnam on Aug. 7.

Sgt. Torbett, who was a first cousin of Donald W. White, vice president and advertising director of Bristol Newspapers, went to Vietnam Nov. 12, 1968.

He entered the Army June 11, 1968 at Fort Bragg, N. C. where he spent eight weeks in basic training before being transferred to Fort Polk, La. for advanced training.

Sgt. Torbett had been wounded twice in combat during the Vietnam war. He was serving with the Fifth Mechanized Division near the DMZ when he was fatally wounded.

Surviving are his wife, the former Jacquelyn Hobbs, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Farrell J. Torbett, Piney Flats, two brothers, Dickie Torbett, stationed with the Navy at Norfolk, and Phillip Torbett, Piney Flats, and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Roy Glover, Piney Flats.

The Communist broadcast, monitored in Tokyo, said the helicopter was shot down over Kumchon, 15 miles north of Pankunjom, the city in the demilitarized zone where truce talks have been in progress since the end of the Korean war.

The United Nations Command said the U.S. helicopter, an OH23, "may have gone down in Communist North Korean territory" after straying across the truce line during a training flight.

A U.N. spokesman said the pilot might have become disoriented and "inadvertently" flown near or over North Korean territory near the Han River estuary 25 to 30 miles north-west of Seoul.

Pyongyang radio called the incident another "provocation by U.S. imperialists in violation of the Korean armistice agreement. There was no mention of the fate of the crewmen.

The UNC spokesman withheld the names of the missing crewmen pending notification of relatives, but a Pentagon source said in Washington that no top-ranking officers were involved.

The pilot radioed shortly after 11 a.m. he had become disoriented, he was being fired upon, was hit and was going down over unknown territory, a United Nations command statement said.

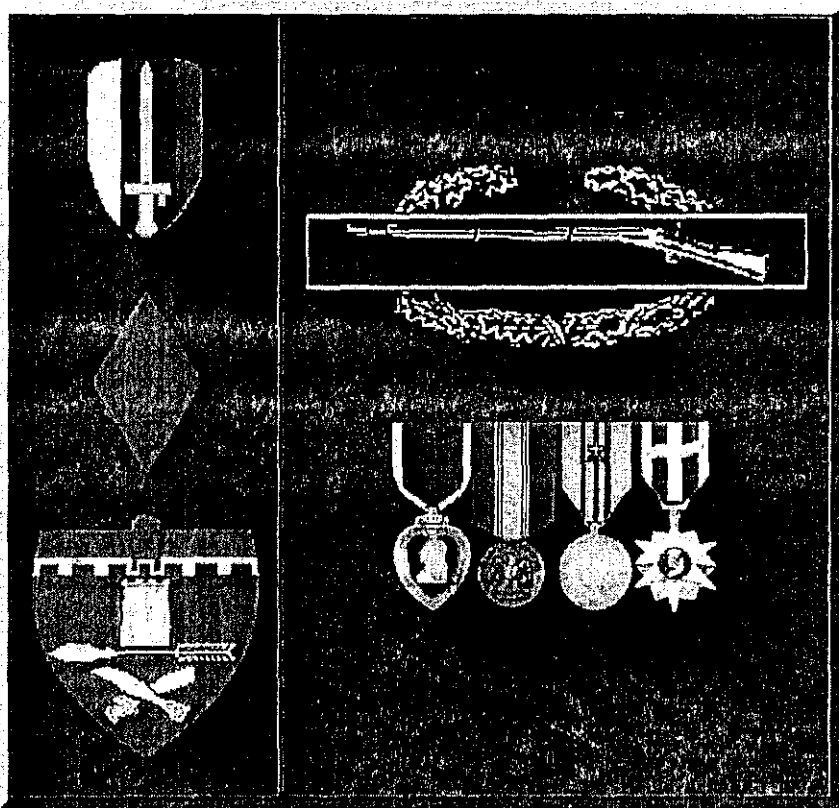

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

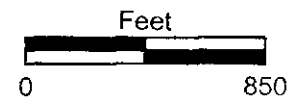

**RESOLUTION To Authorize The Sale Of Surplus Serving Lines To Another Government**

**WHEREAS**, with the closing of Akard and Valley Pike Elementary Schools, the Sullivan County Department of Education has surplus cafeteria serving lines; and

**WHEREAS**, another Tennessee county school system has expressed interest in these serving lines; and

**WHEREAS**, CTAS has stated that a resolution approving the sale needs to be approved by both counties to be in compliance with T. C. A. § 12-3-1005 (Transfers of Surplus Personal Property Among Governmental Entities).

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in Regular Session, hereby authorizes the Sullivan County Purchasing Agent to proceed with the sale of the surplus serving lines by the most appropriate method in which to obtain the most reasonable value. Funds received will be deposited with the Sullivan County Trustee and credited to the school nutrition budget.


