Consider the following:

- (1) **File # 4/98-1** A request by John Hart Jr. to rezone the property described below from R-1 to R-3: REQUEST APPROVED 5/18/98 ROLL CALL 23 Aye, 1 Absent

"Being a tract of land located in the 10th Civil District on the north side of Wayne Construction Rd. approximately 40 feet east of its intersection with Packing House Rd and further described as that portion of parcel 13.20 lying north of Wayne Construction Rd. map 32 of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-1, John Hart Jr. Request

John Hart Jr. requested that a tract of land located in the 10th Civil District on the north side of Wayne Construction Rd. approximately 40 feet east of its intersection with Packing House Rd. be rezoned from R-1 to R-3 to permit the location of a mobile home park.

The applicant was present and spoke in support of the request. Debbie Rowland spoke in opposition to the request citing a potential decrease in residential property values and drainage problems. Staff stated that the request was compatible with existing zoning and land use patterns and recommended approval.

Motion Brown, second Barnes to approve the request as recommended by staff. Vote in favor of the motion unanimous.

- (2) **File # 4/98-2** A request by James Nottingham to rezone the property described below from R-1 to R-2: REQUEST APPROVED 5/18/98 ROLL CALL 23 Aye, 1 Absent

"Being a tract of land located in the 10th Civil District on the east side of Arcadia Dr. approximately 2800 feet north of its intersection with U.S. 11-W and further described as the northernmost portion of parcel 127.40 fronting 120 feet on Arcadia Dr. and being 400 feet in depth map 32 of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-2, James Nottingham Request

James Nottingham requested that a tract of land located in the 10th Civil District on the east side of Arcadia Dr. approximately 2800 feet north of its intersection with U.S. 11-W be rezoned from R-1 to R-2 to permit the location of a single-wide mobile home.

The applicant was present and spoke in support of the request. No opposition was presented. Staff stated the request was incompatible with predominate zoning and land use patterns and recommended the request be denied. The commission asked if the applicant would accept a reduction in the size of the area requested for zoning to 120 feet wide and 400 feet in depth. The applicant accepted commissions suggestion.

Motion Childress, second Barnes to approve the reduced request to R-2 in light of numerous existing mobile homes in the area. Vote in favor of the motion unanimous.

- (3) **File # 4/98-3** A request by Marvin R. Hurst to rezone the property described below from R-1 to B-1: DEFERRED - 30 DAYS - Back to Planning Commission

"Being a tract of land located in the 10th Civil District on the south side of Orebank Rd. at its intersection with Cannon Rd and further described as parcel 13.00 group A map 48A of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-3, Marvin R. Hurst Request

Marvin R. Hurst requested that a tract of land located in the 10th Civil District on the south side of Orebank Rd. at its intersection with Cannon Rd. be rezoned from R-1 to B-3 to permit the location of a grocery store.

The applicant was present. No opposition was presented. Staff stated the request was compatible with existing zoning and land use patterns but suggested the request be changed to B-1 Neighborhood Business. The applicant accepted staff proposal and staff recommended the request for B-1 be approved.

Motion Bennett, second Brown to approve zoning to B-1 as recommended by staff. Vote in favor of the motion: Bennett, Brown, Childress, Mullins; vote opposed: Barnes, Belcher. The motion carried 4 to 2.

- (4) File # 4/98-4 A request by Earl Whittaker to rezone the property described below from R-1 to R-3A:

REQUEST FAILED 5/18/98 ROLL CALL 4 Aye, 19 Nay, 1 Absent  
 "Being a tract of land located in the 9th Civil District on the north side of U.S. 11~~th~~ approximately 2000 feet south of its intersection with Edgefield Rd and further described as that portion of parcel 30.60 lying in Sullivan County map 140 of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-4, Earl Whittaker Request

Earl Whittaker requested that a tract of land located in the 9th Civil District on the north side of U.S. 11~~th~~ approximately 2000 feet south of its intersection with Edgefield Rd. be rezoned from R-1 to R-3A to permit the location of apartments.

The applicant was present and spoke in support of the request. David Rowland and others were present and spoke in opposition to the request stating that it would have a negative impact on adjacent low density residential development. Staff stated the request was not compatible with existing zoning and residential development patterns and recommended the request be denied.

Motion Barnes, second Bennett to deny the request based on opposition statements and staff recommendation. Vote in favor of the motion unanimous.

- (5) File # 4/98-5 A request by Eastman Credit Union to rezone the property described below from R-1 to B-4:

REQUEST APPROVED 5/18/98 ROLL CALL 23 Aye, 1 Absent  
 "Being a tract of land located in the 14th Civil District on the west side of Wendover Dr. approximately 400 feet south of its intersection with Fort Henry Dr and further described as the easternmost rectangular portion of parcel 7.00 40 feet in width group B map 92 J of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-5 Eastman Credit Union Request

Eastman Credit Union requested that a tract of land located in the 14th Civil District on the west side of Wendover Dr. approximately 400 feet south of its intersection with Fort Henry Dr. be rezoned from R-1 to B-4 to permit the location of credit union branch office.

Mr. Prince was present representing the applicant. No opposition was presented. Staff stated the request was compatible with existing zoning and land use patterns and recommended approval.

Motion Mullins, second Childress to approve the request as recommended by staff. Vote in favor of the motion: Mullins, Childress, Brown, Belcher; vote opposed: Bennett, Barnes. The motion carried 4 to 2.

- (6) File # 4/98-6 A request by Fred Childress to rezone the property described below from A-1 to B-3:

"Being a tract of land located in the 13th Civil District on the south side of New Moore Rd. at its intersection with S. Wilcox Dr and further described as that portion of parcel 100 in the southwest quadrant of the intersection of New Moore Rd. and South Wilcox Dr. fronting 250 feet on New Moore Rd. and being 298 feet in depth map 76 of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-6, Fred Childress Request

Fred Childress requested that a tract of land located in the 13th Civil District on the south side of New Moore Rd. at its intersection with S. Wilcox Dr. be rezoned from A-1 to B-3 to permit the location of service station and convenience store.

The applicant was present. No opposition was presented. Staff stated that the request was compatible with existing zoning and land use patterns but that a PBD site plan review process would be preferable. The applicant declined staff suggestion. Staff recommended the request for B-3 be denied.

Motion Barnes, second Belcher to approve the request for B-3 to accommodate the developers need for increased buildable area. Vote in favor of the motion unanimous.

(7) File # 4/98-8 A request by John T. Rosenbalm to rezone the property described below from R-1 to R-2: REQUEST APPROVED 5/18/98 ROLL CALL 22 Aye, 1 Nay, 1 Absent

"Being a tract of land located in the 5th Civil District on the north side of Island Rd. approximately 4000 feet east of its intersection with Johnson Cemetary Rd and further described as that portion of parcel 150.20 fronting on Island Rd. and being 200 feet in depth map 35 of the Sullivan County Tax Maps."

The Planning Commission took the following action:

" File No. 4/98-8, John T. Rosenbalm Request

John T. Rosenbalm requested that a tract of land located in the 5th Civil District on the north side of Island Rd. approximately 4000 feet east of its intersection with Johnson Cemetary Rd. be rezoned from R-1 to R-2 to permit the location of a single-wide mobile home.

The applicant was present and spoke in support of the request. No opposition was presented. Staff stated the request was incompatible with predominate zoning and land use patterns and recommended it be denied.
