WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Sheriff's Office has administered the Tennessee Highway Safety Office grant for a number of years specifically to pay overtime for impaired driving detection and to purchase traffic safety equipment; and

WHEREAS, the 2020-2021 Impaired Driving Enforcement grant application amount is \$60,000.00 with no matching funds required.

RESOLUTION TO EXTEND "EMERGENCY PAID SICK LEAVE ACT" FOR SULLIVAN COUNTY EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to adversely impact thousands of Tennesseans daily. Among these individuals are county employees who like many Americans are faced with the financial impact of missing work if possible exposure to or contraction of the virus dictates that they be quarantined or isolated. On March 18th, 2020 the "Families First Coronavirus Response Act" was enacted which among other benefits and protections afforded employees with 80 hours of emergency paid sick leave if certain criteria were met. This emergency paid sick leave will expire on December 31, 2020, absent congressional action to extend the deadline. In order to assist employees who may be adversely impacted financially due to quarantine or isolation, and to ensure a safe and healthy workplace, the temporary policy adopted by this resolution would extend the expiration date of the "Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act" until the expiration of the Governor's declaration of emergency or June 1, 2021, whichever is sooner. All other provisions of the act would remain the same which includes the total of 80 hours emergency paid sick leave available and the conditions which govern eligibility for the emergency paid sick leave. This resolution does not pertain to the Expanded Family Medical Leave Act which will expire on December 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus known as SARS-CoV-2 was detected in the United States on January 20, 2020, and as a result on January 31,2020, the United States Secretary of Health and Human Services declared a public health emergency due to the infectious nature and debilitating effects caused by the novel coronavirus, and;

WHEREAS, on March 13,2020, the President of the United States issued a proclamation declaring a national emergency based on the COVID-19 outbreak in the United States, and;

WHEREAS, the first case of coronavirus was detected in Tennessee on March 5, 2020, and on March 12,2020, Governor Bill Lee declared a state of emergency to facilitate the treatment and containment of COVID-19, and;

WHEREAS, to assist employees, and to contain the spread of COVID19, the Sullivan County has decided to voluntarily extend the December 31, 2020, expiration date for the emergency paid sick leave until the expiration of Governor Lee's declaration of emergency or June 1, 2021, whichever occurs sooner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in Regular Session hereby authorizes in order to assist employees, and in an effort to contain the spread of COVID19, Sullivan County has decided to voluntarily



extend the December 31, 2020, expiration date for the emergency paid sick leave until the expiration of Governor Lee's declaration of emergency or June 1, 2021, whichever occurs sooner.

WAIVER OF RULES REQUESTED
