RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS AND PURCHASE REAL ESTATE FOR FUTURE SITE OF SULLIVAN COUNTY ARCHIVES

WHEREAS, vacant property located at 3306 Highway 126, Blountville, Tennessee is available for purchase; and,

WHEREAS, the site is an ideal location for the construction of a building to house the Sullivan County Archives and also allows ample space for a 5-10% annual records growth and/or space for other county offices; and,

RESOLUTION TO URGE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ENACT A PRIVATE ACT FOR SULLIVAN COUNTY, TENNESSEE TO LEVY AN HOTEL/OCCUPANCY TAX

WHEREAS, the need for new revenue sources is great in Sullivan County; and

WHEREAS, no additional burden needs to be placed to the property owners of our County;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee assembled in Regular Session, that the Feneral Assembly of the State of Tennessee is urged to enact a private act to authorize Sullivan County to levy a privilege tax on the occupancy of hotels, motels, cabins, bed & breakfasts, air bed & breakfasts and other places that furnish accommodations for a consideration, and that this tax levy may be up to five percent (5%) of the consideration charged for the accommodation, with collection by the County Clerk or such officer as the county legislative body may direct, and with the proceeds from such a tax to be deposited in the fund of the county to be used for such purposes as specified by resolution of the county legislative body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk shall send certified copies of this resolution to the members of the General Assembly representing Sullivan County
