

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CORRECTIONS GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, TENNESSEE CODE ANOTATED SECTION 40-36-101 AUTHORIZES COUNTIES TO Apply for through 40-36-305 and operate a Community Correction Grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee assembled in called Session on the 13th day of June, 1986, the Sullivan County Commission desires to participate in the Tennessee Community THAT Correction Act of 1985 and by this resolution hereby adopts and supports the provisions of said Act; Be it further resolved:

- (1) That the County Commission shall establish a local Community Correction Advisory Board representing a cross section of the local population and insuring minority and female representation.
- (2) That the said Board shall comply in all respects with the provisions of TCA-40-36-201 regarding the composition of the Community Correction Advisory Board.
- (3) That the said Board shall have all the duties set forth in TCA-40-36-202.
- (4) That the Sullivan County Commission does hereby adopt and approve of a plan to be submitted to the Tennessee Department fo Correction by 6-16-86 which plan has been prepared by an Ad Hoc Community Correction advisory board, which board is comprised of representatives of county government, local community resource agencies, Judges of the local courts holding criminal jurisdiction, the District Attorney's Office, the State's local and regional probation directors, and the local director of parole.
- (5) Salaries will be based on Sullivan County wage scale.

(6) Approve for a period of two (2) years or as long as State Funding is available. All resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are rescinded insofar as such conflict exists.

This resolution shall become effective on 13th, June, 1986, the public welfare requiring it.

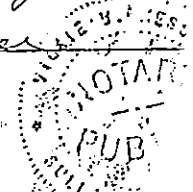

THAT WHEREAS, the 1986 Tax Collections will not be received until October, 1986; and WHEREAS, current fund balances may not be sufficient to cover operating expenses until these tax revenues are received.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners hereby authorized the County Executive, and County Clerk to borrow money on tax anticipation notes, provided such notes are first approved by the Director of Local Finance, to pay for the expenses herein authorized until the taxes and other revenues for the fiscal year 1986-87 have been collected, not exceeding sixty (60%) per cent of the appropriations of each individual fund.

The proceeds of loans for each individual fund shall be used only to pay the expenses and other requirements of the fund for which the loan is made and the loan shall be paid out of revenue of the fund for which the money is borrowed. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this section shall be issued under the authority of Sections 5-10-501 to 5-10-509, inclusive, T.C.A. said notes shall be signed by the County Executive and countersigned by the Court Clerk and shall mature and be paid in full without renewal not later than June 30, 1987.
