Section 1. Chapter 349 of the Private Acts of 1947, as amended, is amended so as to provide in Section 16 of said orginal Act as amended, that from and after September 1, 1974, the compensation of the Judges of the Sessions Court, provided for in said Act, shall be the same as eighty-five percent (85%) of the annual compensation paid to Circuit Judges and Chancellors by the State of Tennessee as provided for in Tennessee Code Annotated Section 8-2303 payable in equal monthly installments from the General Fund of Sullivan County.

Section 2. Be it further enacted, That this Act shall have no effect unless the same shall have been approved by two-thirs vote of the quarterly County Court of Sullivan County, to which it applies, on or before the next regular meeting of such quarterly county court. occuring more than thirty days after its approval by the Chief Executive of this State.
