WHEREAS, a .4 mile section of road, popularly known as "Dividing Ridge" in the First Civil District of Sullivan County is an extension of and connects Morrell Creek Road (county maintained to Old Flatwoods Road (maintained by U. S. Government) in the Cherokee National Forest; and

WHEREAS, for a number of years said .4 mile section of road was, but is no longer, maintained by Sullivan County as a public road; and

WHEREAS, said .4 mile section of road is in constant and increasing use by the general public; and

WHEREAS, said road serves as a primary access route for certain residents, taxpayers, and property owners of Sullivan County living or owning property east of the presently maintained termination point of Morrell Creek Road; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Forest Service is the sole property owner adjoining each side of said .4 mile section of road and said U. S. Forest Service has formerly requested Sullivan County accept and include said road in the county road system; and

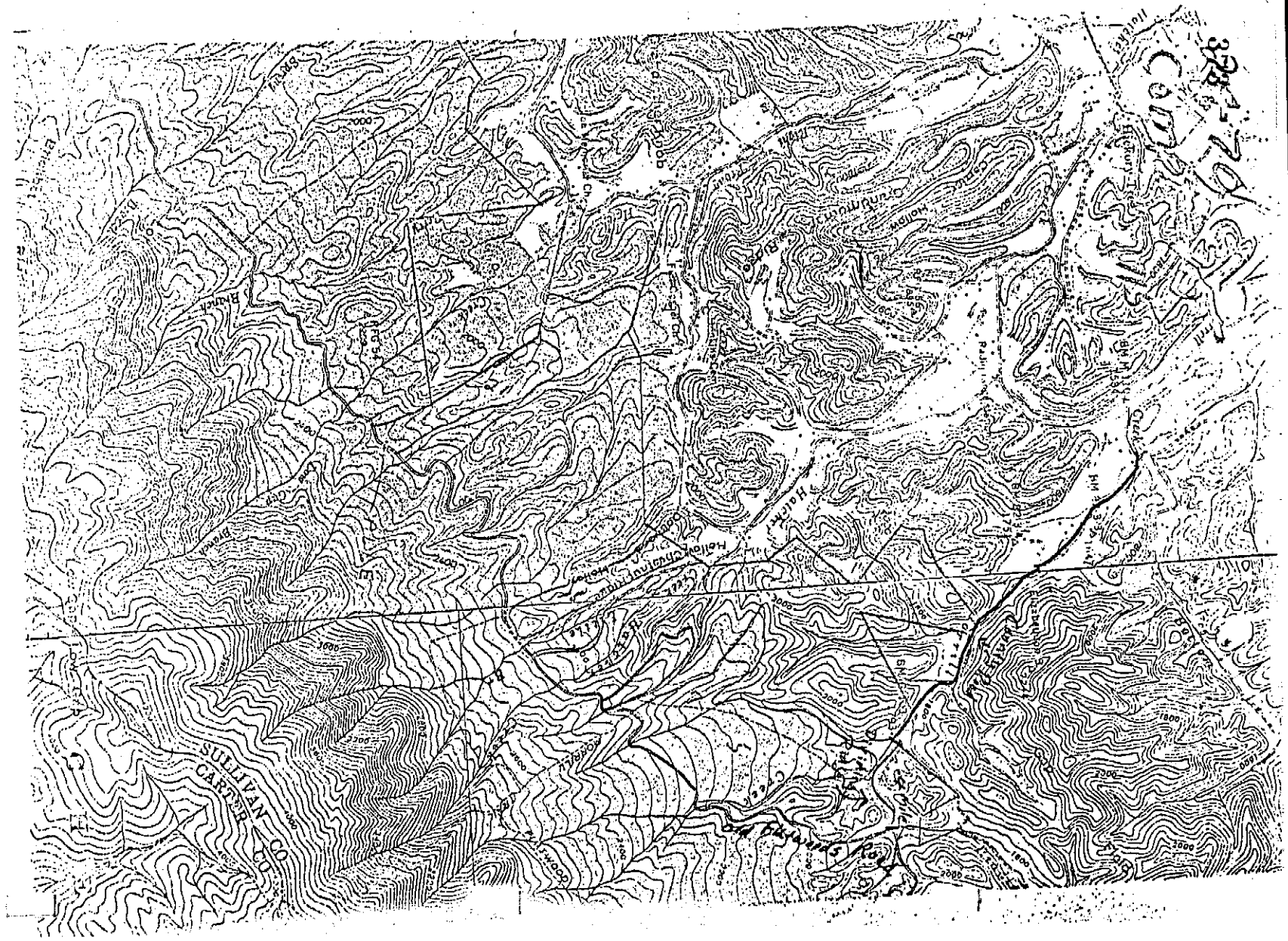

The Sullivan County Department of Human Services Child Welfare Fund is respectfully requesting an \$18,500.00 supplement for the fiscal year 1978-79. Actual expenditures for the first six months of fiscal year 1978-79 are \$33,910.47. We anticipate an expenditure of at least \$34,000.00 for the remaining half of the year. Without any additional funds, we would exceed our approved budget of \$50,000.00 by \$17,910.47. We feel the \$18,500.00 supplement request is necessary and reasonable due to an increase in children coming into foster care. We are continuing to place more children in foster homes than in the Sullivan Youth Center and more board payments have been necessary. Also, effective July 1, 1978, board rates statewide were increased by \$75.00 and initial clothing outlays were increased by \$15.00 to \$45.00 depending upon the child's age. We have had to pay more medical bills that have not been covered by Medicaid.

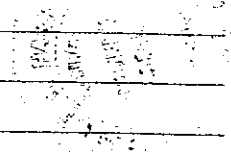
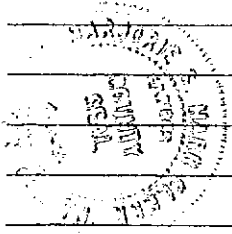

The Board of Commissioners hereby urges the Sullivan County legislative delegation to the General Assembly to introduce and work for passage of a Private Act to be substantially as follows:

AN ACT relevant to the regulation and
licensing of automobile graveyards,
and the enforcement of such, in
Sullivan County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. As used in this act "automobile graveyard" means any lot or place which is exposed to the weather and upon which more than five (5) motor vehicles of any kind, incapable of being operated, and which it would not be economically practical to make operative, are placed, located or found. The term "automobile graveyard" or "automobile junkyard" shall ~~not~~ be construed to mean an establishment having facilities for processing iron, steel or nonferrous scrap and whose principal produce is scrap iron, steel or nonferrous scrap for sale for remedying purposes only.

SECTION 2. The legislative body of Sullivan County, by resolution, may regulate and license the maintenance of automobile graveyards, as defined above, and may prescribe civil fines for violations of such regulations, which civil fines shall not be in excess of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each violation.

SECTION 3. No resolution authorized by Section 2 of this act shall be adopted until after notice of intention to

propose the same for adoption shall have been published prior to its adoption once a week for two (2) successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Sullivan County, and no such resolution shall become effective until it shall have been published in full for two (2) successive weeks in a like newspaper.

SECTION 4. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of Sullivan County before July 1, 1979. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the Sullivan County legislative body and certified by him to the Secretary of State.

SECTION 5. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective on July 1, 1979.
