and adopted by a roll call vote of the court and is in the following words and figures, to-wit

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

In accordance with previous recommendations of the Health and Welfare Committee and meetings of the County Judge with officials of Hawkins County and HAAP and recognizing an insect problem exists in the lower end of Sullivan County and the necessity of taking immediate action to aid and assist the citizens of Sullivan County;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Quarterly County Court of Sullivan County, recognizing that an insect problem does exist in Sullivan County, does hereby empower and authorize the County Judge of Sullivan County to enter into a negotiate a contract with the appropriate local, state and federal officials, if necessary, for the control and elimination of insects in Sullivan County.

The Quarterly County Court of Sullivan County further empowers the County Judge to expend a sum not exceeding Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, plus the use of county vehicles and personnel, if needed, to combat this insect problem.

The contract for the control and elimation of insects must be approved by the Health and Welfare Committee and must be administered under the supervision of the Sullivan County Health Department.

All sums expended in this program must be approved by the Sullivan County Budget Committee.

This money is to be appropriated from the General Fund Surplus of the fiscal year 1971-72
