RESOLUTION IN RE: School Bond Issue for Central Heights Elem. School Replacement

BE IT RESOLVED THAT

WHEREAS, Central Heights Elementary School has been destroyed by fire leaving 248 students without classroom space, and,

WHEREAS, Indian Springs Elementary School is seriously overcrowded, and,

WHEREAS, Indian Springs Community is the most rapidly growing community in Sullivan County,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT three million dollars (2,500,000)\* be appropriated by the Sullivan County Quarterly Court by issuing bonds and 500,000 from General Purpose School Surplus for the construction of a school to accomodate 700 students from the Central Heights and Indian Springs areas.

\*3,900,000.00 needed to include Bristol and Kingsport share. This resolution would eliminate previous request for \$800,000.00 renovation at Central Heights & \$2,500,000.00 for elementary school at Indian Springs.


