BE IT RESOLVED THAT

SECTION 1- The Resolution of the Quarterly Court of Sullivan County, Tennessee, imposing a local sales and use tax as authorized under the provisions of Section 67-3049-3056 T. C. A. adopted by the Court at an Adjourned Session on February 14, 1966, as recorded in Minute Book No. 2, page 179-180, is amended to levy a local sales and use tax at a rate of three-sevenths of the present state rate, as provided in the Retailers Sales Tax Act under Chapter 30, Title 57, T. C. A., as the same may be amended and authorized, and to increase the maximum tax on the sale or use of any signle item to \$7,50.

SECTION 2 - If a majority of those voting in the election required by Section 67-3053 T. C. A., vote for the increase in the tax imposed by this Resolution, collection of the increased tax levied by this resolution shall begin on the first day of the month occurring 30 or more days after the County Election.
