WHEREAS upon the request of the Sullivan County Historical Commission, this resolution is herein submitted to the Sullivan County Court.

WHEREAS a historical book, of approximately 225 page, designating by photograph and description, the outstanding historical sites and structures located in Sullivan County, Tennessee, has been in progress of completion by the Sullivan County Historical Commission, it is necessary that this work be recognized by the Sullivan County Court.

The members of the Sullivan County Historical Commission have, to date, expended countless hours of their time, plus much private expenditure of their own money, collecting the historical data and taking photographs of the historical sites in Sullivan County. Four hundred and seven pages of historical data on forms xeroxed by a member of the Commission have been accumulated.

It is the recommendation of the Sullivan County Historical Commission that this valuable work be compiled into a manuscript and be published for all of the citizens of Sullivan County. It is further recommended that this be dedicated as a Sullivan County project to commemorate Sullivan County's participation in the American Revolution Bicentennial.

The cost of publishing this manuscript has been estimated, at this date, to be seven thousand dollars (\$7000). The Sullivan County Historical Commission herein requests ~~the Sullivan County Court~~ the Sullivan County Court to ~~approve~~ ^{authorize} this sum which, with the exception of five hundred dollars (\$500), will be payable to printers and editors on or before July, 1975. The ~~amount~~ ^{sum} of five hundred dollars (\$500) is herein request of the Sullivan County Court to be available by September, 1973, for the purpose of completing the photographic work for the publication.

Upon the sale of the book, the total funds appropriated by the Sullivan County Court in regard to publishing this book, will be refunded to the Sullivan County Court.

The proposed publication of the HISTORICAL SITES OF SULLIVAN COUNTY, TENNESSEE will not only be of great value to the citizens of Sullivan County but also to the people of the State of Tennessee and of the United States of America.


