WHEREAS, THE SULLIVAN COUNTY COURT HAS PASSED A RESOLUTION DIRECTING  
THE ATTORNEY FOR THE COUNTY OF SULLIVAN TO FILE LITIGATION AGAINST  
THE ANNEXATION PLANS BY THE CITY OF KINGSPORT, AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF KINGSPORT PASSED ON THIRD READING ON 8/15/78  
PLANS TO ANNEX BY ORDINANCE APPROXIMATELY 42 SQ. MILES OF SULLIVAN  
COUNTY AND APPROXIMATELY 20,000 CITIZENS AGAINST THEIR WISHES WITHOUT  
ALLOWING THESE CITIZENS A RIGHT TO VOTE ON SAID ANNEXATION, AND

WHEREAS, LITIGATION IS REQUIRED TO BE FILED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF  
PASSAGE OF SAID ANNEXATION ON THIRD READING, AND

WHEREAS, THE PEOPLE IN SULLIVAN COUNTY, CITY AND RURAL, VOTED IN  
1974 AND ADOPTED BY A MARGIN OF 3 TO 1 A LAW (CHAPTER 25, PUBLIC  
ACTS, 1973, HOUSE BILL NUMBER 179), ALLOWING THE PEOPLE AFFECTED,

CITY AND COUNTY, TO RATIFY OR REJECT AN ANNEXATION BY ORDINANCE, AND

WHEREAS, A PETITION, AS REQUIRED BY LAW, REQUESTING A REFERENDUM TO

RATIFY OR REJECT THIS ANNEXATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE MAYOR OF  
KINGSPORT, AND ALSO TO THE SULLIVAN COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION, AND

WHEREAS, SECTION I OF THIS LAW STATES THAT "WITHIN NINETY (90) DAYS


