of an "Emergency Communications District, and

WHEREAS, the voters of Sullivan County did overwhelmingly vote in favor of the establishment of the Emergency Communications District on August 7, 1986 as certified by the Election Commission, and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Chapter 867 of the Public Acts of 1984 provides that this body may create an Emergency Communications District upon the approval of the voters and may appoint a Board of Directors of not less than seven nor more than nine members to govern the affairs of the district and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens on Sullivan County that said Board of Directors consist of nine members with certain positions designated as representing various governmental agencies, emergency service suppliers, and citizens, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Sullivan County that said Board of Directors be structured in such a way that there are two representatives from the City of Kingsport, two representatives from the City of Bristol, one representative from the City of Bluff City, one member of the County Commission, one representative from the volunteer fire departments, and one representative from the emergency medical services and one representative from the county.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Sullivan County, the Board of Directors of the Emergency Communication District may establish such advisory committees as deemed appropriate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners in regular session assembled this 15th day of September, 1986 that there is hereby established the Emergency Communications District of Sullivan County pursuant to Chapter 867 of the Public Acts of 1984 and the jurisdiction and boundaries of said district shall be the boundaries of Sullivan County and a portion of Hawkins County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Emergency Communications District of Sullivan County shall be composed of nine members, serving staggered terms

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the nine members of said Board of Directors initially shall consist of the following persons:

1. Randy Grimes, Chief Deputy of the Sullivan County Sheriff's Department.

2. Nick Russin, Sullivan County Commissioner.
3. *Don Baiger, Sullivan County Commissioner*
4. Ike Lowry, Bluff City Rescue Squad.
5. Phil Vinson, Fire Chief of Bristol, Tennessee.
6. Jerry Pulliam, City Manager of Bristol, Tennessee.

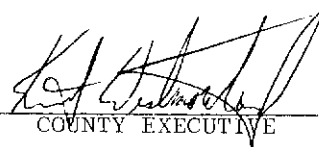
